The bid shall include mowing of the ball field and surrounding park area on an approximate weekly schedule for the months of May through mid-June and bi-weekly late-June through approximately September (weather dependant). Weed whipping will be required at least 3 times through the season as well as leaves and debris cleanup in the Fall. A schedule will be developed with the winning bidder and the Parks & Recreation Committee based on public use of the Park.
