

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMEN'S MEETING
June 21, 2016

Selectmen Present: Tom Seymour, Bob Dupuis, Mike Brady, Linda Henry (Assistant)

DAN BOYCE: Pastor Boyce and his wife Sandi asked about getting keys made to the Library as Sandi is a Trustee. Selectman Dupuis will look into this. They asked to use the Town Hall to have a "Good News Club" after school during the school year. The Board said to go through the usual procedure by filling out an application, but they have no problem with it.

HIGHWAY DEPT: Selectmen entered into nps at 6:40pm to discuss a personnel issue. Nps ended at 6:45pm. Road Agent, Dean Stevenson, talked about hiring another driver to assist with hauling materials. They discussed the deterioration of Bunker Hill Rd. Bridge and what is the best way to proceed with replacement.

TOWN CLERK: Desiree Mahurin presented the unlicensed dog warrant to the Board. She said that Shelly Henry, her interim replacement, will attend the Motor Vehicle training the week of July 11th. The office will be closed the week of July 4th. Shelly cannot do anything prior to being sworn in. She offered to assist Shelly with training etc. and to stay on as an employee to fill in when needed. A motion was made by Selectman Dupuis to keep Desiree on as an employee to train etc. Selectman Seymour seconded. All agreed. She will be paid an hourly wage only when coming into the office.

TRANSFER STATION: Selectmen discussed closing the transfer station on Old Home Day, August 20th so that the attendant could enjoy the festivities. The replacement attendant will be asked to fill in.

MISC: Selectmen approved an application for a veteran's credit. Steven Thomson was appointed to the Zoning Board. He was sworn in by Selectman Seymour.
