Looking into replacing backhoe with lease agreement (10 yr. 15,295/7 yr. 20,933.) with 2 ½ % upfront Dean felt wouldn't be much of trade-in, town should leave at transfer station to save on wear and tear on new piece of equipment current backhoe needs new front end with cost estimate of roughly 10,000. to fix.

Gerry made motion to accept minutes as read, Pat 2nd motion, vote was unanimous

Disscussion on lowering number of budget committee. Currently have 4 vacancies along with all town positions becoming harder to fill Lisa felt it may be a good time to reduce the Budget Committee positions. With hopes making a quarum easier to reach for meetings This would be a warrant article and voted at town meeting.

Gerry made motion to lower number to 9, Pat 2nd motion, vote was unanimous

Tom mentioned town is working on possible new heath insurance carrier currently checking for equal coverage on Policy for employees.

Question on possiblility of combining with school insurance, might not work due to policy time frames Tom will check on this.

Tom mentioned \$50,000.00 would be used to offset taxes rate would roughly go from 25.93 down to 25.30.

Chris Valese spoke on the possibility of conflict of interest with currant town clerk/ tax collector being on the budget committee as School Board representative and stepping aside would eliminate this possibility. He also listed the technology problems with the new website for the town.

Disscussion felt the concerns Chris spoke of would be better addressed with the selectmen.

Tom was given notes on the problems with the website by Chris in order to look further into fixing the website issues with the selectmen.

Lisa reminded everyone the next meeting date is Dec. 1, at 7:00 p.m. Pat motion to adjourn, Joe 2nd motion, vote was unanimous
