SELECTMEN'S MEETING
April 17, 2018

Selectmen Present: Tom Seymour, Mike Brady, and Lisa Seymour (Administrative Assistant)

Selectmen Absent: Bob Dupuis

Public: Marshall Bennett

Tom Seymour brought the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Fire Dept: Dee Ford reported that there was a motor vehicle accident on the Borough Road. Sunday they received a 911 fire call for a potential fire on the Borough. This property has health hazards in the yard. There was discussion about changing the zoning ordinances to address the clutter and amount of unregistered vehicles on a property. Mike Brady mentioned that they tried to change the ordinances in 2006. Health Officer Dee Ford is still working with 10 Commerce Street.

Highway Dept: Dean Stevenson was absent, but wanted the selectmen to know that Reed has the grader back together and they still need to test it. They have currently spent \$13,000 on the repairs.

Police Dept: Chief Stevens no report

Town Clerk/Tax Collector: Shelly Henry no report

PUBLIC SESSION: Marshall Bennett has concerns about the speed on Addison Drive. Currently there are no speed limit signs stating it should 25 miles an hour. The ATV traffic has been going through 48 Addison Road to Old Town Road. Mike Brady stated that this is not part of the ATV trails. Marshall has reached out to NH Fish and Game, but has not heard back from them. Marshall was also concerned about the excessive screeching of tires in the middle of the night.

BOARD BUSINESS:

Six building permits were signed off by the selectmen.

Rod Wood will be here on April 30th to start preparing for the first tax warrant to be issued in mid-May.

Advanced Lock & Alarm is coming in May 1st to discuss with the Selectmen their options for changing the locking system at the Town Hall and Offices.


Chief Ford and Lisa Seymour are still working on updates to the 911 maps.
