

ANNUAL HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION 2018

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) collection will be held on August 4th from 8:30 am to 12 noon. On August the 4th there are four HHW collection sites and the closest site in the Newfound region will be at the NH DOT garage on Ayers Island Road and next to the Wells Baseball field in Bristol. If you are not able to make HHW on August 4th there are four other collection locations a week earlier on July 28th.

Some of the local participating towns, which are near the Bristol collection site, are Alexandria, Andover, Bridgewater, Bristol, Franklin, Hebron, Hill, Holderness, Meredith and New Hampton.

How much can one household bring to HHW? 10 gallons or 50 pounds.

What are household hazardous wastes? Household hazardous wastes are substances that *poison* or *contaminate* the environment and *threaten* the *health* of those in the local community. They may be **flammable, corrosive, reactive, or toxic** and should be disposed of properly so as not to harm people or damage the region's soil and water resource's. HHW COLLECTION DOES NOT EXCEPT LATEX PAINTS or COMMERCIAL WASTE.
