- b. Friends of the Library will meet on April 19th.
- c. There will be a program on Pollinators aimed primarily for children on April 25th, during the school spring break.
- d. April 30 and every Tuesday thereafter for 6 weeks, there will be a program for care-givers, assuming enough people sign up for the program to justify doing it. This is a Service Link program and requires a minimum of 5 participants. Lynn will check April 12th to see if there are enough people signed up.
- e. Kathy has approached a watercolorist who will be willing to put up an exhibition of her work, give a demonstration, and possibly give classes. We would like to pursue this come fall.
- f. Sandy has contacted another watercolorist who could assemble a show for the Library soon.
- g. Lucy will be working with the younger students at the school to create a Community Quilt that could be displayed next to the reproduction of the town's Bicentennial Quilt.

The April 9th program featuring a New Hampshire Master Gardener talking about herbs was very well attended. 37 patrons came.

2. Discuss changes in the case.

We would like to change the displays in the case on a regular basis to compliment featured programs and/or areas of study at the school.

We will investigate to possibility of assembling a display on Beekeeping to coincide with the Pollinators program.
