Unreserved Fund Balance 5-17% range of budget recommended by DRA from tax base

Capitol Reserve Fund can be spent in two ways (1) thru warrant articles passed at town meeting (2) selectmen appointed as agents to expend the fund

Tax rate is set by the town vote to be spent, amount town receives in revenues, rest is made up from town taxation

Fire Dispatch formula with Lakes Region (1) valuation of town 50% (2) population ? 50% make up cost assessed to town

Police Dispatch contract between Franklin and Hill departments

Line items are mandated from DRA why ambulance is not under Fire Dept.

SPCA contract between Hill Police and Franklin shelter if no owner found

Payroll taxes are entered in one system during year then are separated at end of year

Talked about Covid-19 concerns on school budget. Carol felt they were in good shape with all that has been going on. She said the because students have received computers they were one of the best in the state for on line learning. The school has received around \$ 12,000.00 from the state to help with dealing with Covid -19 they haven't used up funds since they were ahead of other schools with not having to provide extra computers.
