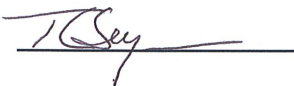

With no further business to conduct, motion was made and unanimously approved to adjourn at 7:45 pm.

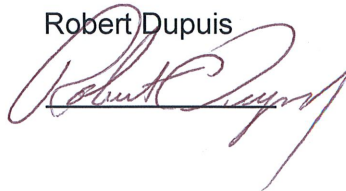
