First order of business was to make sure everyone was respecting the physical distancing and wearing masks orders issued by Governor Sununu.

Fire Dept: Jeff Ford reported that they had three calls putting the year-to-date total to 24 calls. They are currently working on the paperwork for the Association. At the Thursday meeting they will be looking to see what they need order for medical supplies. Lakes Region Fire Apparatus is going to look into the cost to replace the air tank on the board compressor on engine 2. April 22nd the rescue truck will be going over to Dingee Machine for service. The dead battery is caused by too much starting and stopping because the glow plugs need to warm up before shutting down the truck. Engine 4 has a lot of issues.


Robert Dupuis made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Shaun Bresnahan seconded the motion. All in favor

With no further business to conduct, motion was made and unanimously approved to adjourn at 8:24 pm.


