Workshop:

The Selectmen met with Chief Jamie Moulton to review the 2023 budget. They also discussed the generator maintenance for the emergency shelter located at the Jennie B. Blake School. The generator needs to be serviced also asked Jamie to investigate annual service contract for the generator. Chief Moulton also asked about how future purchase of fire trucks is handled. Brief discussion on Fire Heavy equipment Capital Reserved Fund. Also discussed potential for replacing the roof and heating system by warrant article in 2023. The officers are as follows: Chief Jamie Moulton, Deputy Fire Chief Mark Labonte, Captain Nathan Mills and Lieutenant Marshall Bennett.

The selectmen's workshop was recessed at 6:32 to enter into the Water Commissioners meeting.

The board reviewed the 2023 budget presentation for the presentation to the budget committee.

Discussed the removal of the sidewalks on Mountain View Drive that was approved at the Town Meeting and needs to be done before year end.

Setting up the capital reserve account for Legal expense was discussed. This was also approved at the Town Meeting.

Updated the board on the mapping process with Avitar and the wellhead overlay from Lakes Region Planning Commission.

Lisa Seymour has submitted the 911 request for the Dickerson Hill School and is just waiting for the paperwork to be processed.

Brian St. Germain from 16 Moses Avenue came into to discuss a building permit for a Tuff Shed because the original location was in the town right-of-way. The permit was approved after discussing the location and the reason it could not be placed on a town right-of-way.

With no further business to conduct, Thomas Seymour made the motion to adjourn the meeting and Shaun Bresnahan seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously at 8:30 pm.
