December 13, 2022

Tom Seymour brought the meeting to order at 8:26 pm.

Workshop:

The Selectmen met to review and update their 2023 total Town budget. Shaun Bresnahan stated the 2023 Selectmen review for the Budget Committee has been moved into January. However, the Budget Committee would like to review the estimated revenues on December 21st meeting. Lisa Seymour will provide the updated worksheet at next week's Selectmen's meeting.

The town received two loads of salt and Dale Wheeler had the winter tires mounted on the 6500.

The Selectmen discussed a plan for Friday's storm. The Selectmen are looking into several options to ensure the town is properly plowed. Shaun Bresnahan reached out to Danny Woodhams, of SKR, to see if he has anyone that can plow but has not heard back. Shaun is reaching out to Cory Corliss to see if he would be interested. If there is nobody, Shaun Bresnahan said he could help out. The 6500 will have a front plow and sander so it doesn't go over the gross weight. Dale is going to put the chains on Tony's truck so it will be ready for Friday's storm. Robert Dupuis has offered to help by shoveling and sanding the Town Office building. This will be done throughout the storms. Robert Dupuis quoted \$25.00 per trip to keep everything open. Shaun Bresnahan made a motion to accept the quote for the shoveling and sanding of \$25.00 per trip in the event of a snow storm. Frank Razzaboni seconded the motion. All in favor.

Thank you to Dale Wheeler as he did a great job with Monday's storm and school was not delayed.

Walter Waring had a conversation with the residents on Murray Hill Road that he thought were trespassing on his property. They have worked out everything.

Ruth Cross on Bunker Hill has a dwelling on her property and the land is in current use. She will need to be notified of the current use usage.

Shaun Bresnahan will write a thank you letter to Nikolaos Manolis for his donation of gift cards.

Frank Razzaboni is going to look into getting a sign for the Cass Mill Bridge to restrict heavy equipment and trucks from crossing it.

318 Cass Mill Road has several structures on Lot R3-2. We will need to send a letter of cease and desist because they are in violation of the zoning ordinances.


The Wallace court date has been changed to January 23. Frank Razzaboni will go and represent the Town.


