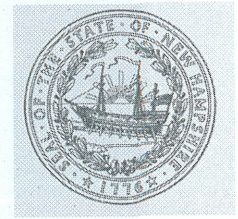

Dear Owner:

The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services ("NHDES") issued a Boil Order to the subject water system on December 30, 2023. As a result of efforts to correct the problem, and the submission of water samples demonstrating the absence of total coliform bacteria, NHDES hereby approves the lifting of the Boil Order.

Pursuant to NH Administrative Rule Env-Dw 709.19 (c) (3), the owner of a water system must notify all customers that the Boil Order has been lifted.
