What do I need to register?

1. A Voter Registration Form from the Town Clerk or Supervisor of the Checklist.
2. Proof of U.S. Citizenship – birth certificate, US passport, or court naturalization papers. *A New Hampshire Real ID compliant driver's license is NOT proof of U.S. Citizenship.*
3. Proof of identity and age – driver's license, government-issued photo ID, or passport. (Must be age 18 by Election Day.)
4. NH Residence (legal domicile) – NH driver's license or government-issued photo ID showing your current NH residence address. If your photo ID shows a former address, you will need a deed, lease agreement, utility bill or vehicle registration showing your current address.

NOTE: A person who does not drive, but is eligible to vote (age 18 by Election Day, a U.S. citizen & NH legal resident), can obtain a photo ID for voting purposes from the Department of Motor Vehicles. A voucher form must be obtained from the Town Clerk or Secretary of State's Office to submit to DMV with your request.
