July 29, 2025

Meeting Brought to order: 4:55 PM by Peggy Razzaboni

The committee met with Ms. Reed and Mr. Ramsay concerning lot 5C in range 18 of Pleasant Hill Cemetery. Our records show it is a 2-person lot, she will be burying her daughter and her brother in said lot. She believes there are 2 lots which are side by side as opposed to 1 lot for 2 burials. She will provide a copy of the bill of sale and the burial certificates on Wednesday the 30th of July. The stone was place by Perry Monument however neither she nor the committee received notice of when this would be done. As a result, the stone does not have the correct placement for two burials as she will also be putting a marker for her brother. This will be corrected and corner markers as required will be ordered by Ms. Reed. Ms. Reed and Mr. Ramsay will inform us of the date and time the correction will take place. She was also given information that Laconia Monument is back in business and may be a bit less expensive. Lastly, she will meet with a trustee at 8:00 a.m. on 7/30/2025 at the Pleasant Hill cemetery to double check and provide the above-mentioned paperwork.

7. Contact information for the Cemetery committee need to be changed from the Selectman's office to the Town Clerks office. L.S. to do. _____


8. Next meeting to be August 13, 2025 at 5:00 at the library.


